Dear Mr. Hoffman:

Attached is a copy of Administrative Amendment #2022.042 to the Pima Association of Governments (PAG) FY 2022-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The amendment contains the following items:

- Item A programs regional intergovernmental agreement (IGA) actions related to the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) Environmental and Economic Vitality Categorical 41, Greenways, Pathways, Bikeways and Sidewalks, Funding Exchange Proposals program.
- Item B programs a regional IGA action related to the FY 2023-2026 Competitive Regional Transportation Alternative Grant program (RTAG) and RTA Environmental and Economic Vitality Categorical 41, Greenways, Pathways, Bikeways and Sidewalks.
- Item C programs additional RTA and local funding on RTA Element 1 Roadway Improvement, Ballot Number 16. Downtown Links, I-10 to Broadway.
- Item D moves Highway Improvement Program - Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) funding from FY 2023 to FY 2024, initially awarded through the FY 2021 Supplemental Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA).
- Item E programs a new roadway project with local funding as requested by the sponsoring jurisdiction.

I have reviewed the amendment, and I concur that it meets established policies for administrative amendments on behalf of PAG.
