Background and Role of the TPC

- Established in 1975.
- TPC is a standing technical advisory committee.
- Provides technical review and develops recommendations on studies, reports, plans and programs developed by PAG.
- Supports PAG staff in development of the TIP.
- Monitors current TIP progress and implementation status of approved TIP projects.
- Supports PAG staff in development of PAG's long-range regional transportation plan (RMAP).



>> TPC Reporting Requirements

- Reports to the PAG Executive Director.
- Provides direction to any standing advisory subcommittee and reviews, approves and forwards recommendations as needed from those subcommittees.

Committee Operating Guidelines

- The PAG Executive Director directs staff in the implementation of PAG's operations.
- Standing advisory committees address and implement specific tasks as assigned by PAG.
- Committees have no administrative role and are not tasked with any contractual negotiations or any administrative affairs of PAG and the RTA and their operations.
