Notice is hereby given to the public and to the Committee members that the Air Quality Subcommittee (AQS) of the Environmental Planning Advisory Committee (EPAC) of Pima Association of Governments (PAG) will meet at the above stated time and date. The following is an agenda of the matters to be considered, discussed and acted upon.

SPECIAL NOTICE: Members of the AQS will attend the meeting remotely. The meeting room will be closed to the public. However, members of the public are invited to attend the meeting via the public access link above. Committee members will be provided with a separate link to participate. These comments will be filed with the committee's records.

AQS is a subcommittee of EPAC, a technical advisory committee established by PAG to make regional environmental planning recommendations to the PAG Executive Director. AQS reports to EPAC on an as-needed basis and works on assigned key activities that need to be addressed. AQS evaluates regional compliance issues relating to the 1977 Clean Air Act; reviews and makes recommendations about air quality plans and proposals, such as non-attainment and maintenance area plans; and identifies air-related priorities and provides guidance on these issues to EPAC. Committee members are prohibited from interfering with administrative functions of the organization.
