**RE: Administrative Amendment #2022.114**

Dear Ms. Hobert:

Attached is a copy of Administrative Amendment #2022.114 to the Pima Association of Governments (PAG)

FY 2022-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The amendment contains the following:

- Item A addresses programming of HURF exchange (in place of RTAG award funds) and RTA funds for FY 2025 and FY 2026 for the Town of Sahuarita.
- Item B addresses programming of RTAG award, RTA, and local funds for FY 2025 and FY 2026 for Pima County.
- Item C defers programmed RTA funds for construction from FY25 to FY26 due to ongoing evaluation of design alternatives and stakeholder engagement.
- Item D addresses programming of USDOT Reconnecting Communities and Neighborhoods Program grant and local funds for the City of Tucson.
  - Per the most recent guidance from ADOT: For increased visibility and clarity, “RCN grant” was added as a fund type.

I have reviewed the amendment, and I concur that it meets established policies for administrative amendments on behalf of PAG.
