**RE: Amendment #2025.004**

Dear Ms. Hobert:

Attached is a copy of Amendment #2025.004 to the Pima Association of Governments (PAG) FY 2025-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The amendment contains the following items:

- Item A addresses a scrivener's error where RTA funding should have been rolled forward to FY 2025 from previous years for TIP IDs 86.09 and 89.01.
- Item B shifts Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant funding from FY 2024 to FY 2025 for TIP ID 131.00 at the City of Tucson's request.
- Item C addresses a phase change for Regional Transportation Alternatives Grant (RTAG) funding for TIP ID 3.23 at the Town of Oro Valley's request.
- Item D shifts Congressionally Directed Spending (CDS) and local match funds from FY 2025 to FY 2026 and reduces the local match at the City of Tucson's request.

I have reviewed the amendment, and I concur that this TIP amendment complies with ADOT's guidelines per [ADOT's TIP Amendment Guidelines](#) and aligns with PAG's TIP policies and procedures in Appendix 3 of the [approved FY 2025 – FY 2029 TIP](#).
