





Identify Strategic Network Packages

Package 1. Maximize Need-Based Connectivity


Focus the high-priority network on areas with high active transportation propensity and limited active transportation options.

Package 2. Maximize Overall Accessibility

Focus the high-priority network on reaching the maximum number of potential active transportation trips across the PAG region.


Package 3. Maximize Safety

Focus the high-priority network on addressing data-driven and perceived active transportation safety issues.






Develop Evaluation Criteria and Weighting

Preferred High-Priority Network Options


- Use one of the scenario networks.
