WPS is a technical subcommittee established by PAG to make regional environmental planning recommendations to the Environmental Planning Advisory Committee, which reports to the Management Committee and PAG Executive Director. WPS provides technical review and develops recommendations on studies, reports, plans, programs and submittals in support of continuous, comprehensive and cooperative sustainability planning and programming within the PAG planning area and in full compliance with PAG policies and procedures.
